## The Challenge:

CYRO Industries has more than 600 employees and maintains widely dispersed operations, including four manufacturing locations, eight sales offices, eight distribution centers, two customer service centers, and one research and technical center. As an incentive, CYRO provides an additional \$50 in cash for the next plan year to employees who participate in the physical exam program. From the start, CYRO contracted with Comprehensive Health Services (CHS) to manage the examinations.

## The CHS Response:

CHS has conducted annual exams for participating CYRO employees age 50 and older (less frequently for younger employees), for nearly a decade. Through CHS' streamlined process, CYRO provides a list of eligible employees. CHS then notifies employees, explains the program, and invites them to participate. Participating employees are scheduled for exams. A board-certified physician reviews all exam and lab results and sends the employee a full report. Should results show medical concern, CHS contacts the employee immediately. CHS addresses two crucial areas of concern:

- Making exams conveniently accessible to CYRO's widely dispersed workforce
- Educating employees about the confidentiality of the program and the value of risk assessment, prevention, early detection and intervention.
