FITNESS-FOR-DUTY AND RETURN-TO-WORK

A **fitness-for-duty (FFD) medical evaluation** is typically triggered by an unexpected incident involving an employee, such as an accident, witnessed or reported unusual behavior, or concern that health or medications may pose a threat to health or safety in the workplace.

An FFD examination is an open-ended medical evaluation that may include multiple components.

The goal is to ensure that the employee can safely return to work without posing a threat to his or her health, coworkers, or the public.

A **return-to-work (RTW) medical evaluation** is an evaluation of an employee who has been out of work due to a medical condition (often resulting in a short-term or long-term disability leave). The intent of such an evaluation is to ensure that an employee can safely return to work without posing a threat to his or her health or without posing a threat to coworkers, the public, or the workplace.

The RTW evaluation is an open-ended medical evaluation by the employee's physician.
